The International Painting Contest Hai Phong 2025.

1. Organizing agency: Department of Foreign Affairs

2. Contest Theme: "The City of the Future"

3. Related Information:

3.1 Timeframe

- Artwork reception period: From March 25th, 2025, to May 24th, 2025
- Assessment period: From May 26th to May 29th, 2025
- Results announcement date: May 31st, 2025

3.2 Participants:

- Group 1: Contestants aged 6 - 10 years old
- Group 2: Contestants aged 11 - 15 years old

Participants must be children or teenagers from Hai Phong and other localities or international cities with friendly relations or sister-city partnerships with Hai Phong.

3. Contest Requirements:

The artworks should revolve around the theme of the city of the future. Contestants are encouraged to express their dreams, feelings, and imagination about the city of the future.

- The drawings must meet all the requirements set by the Contest Organizing Committee.

- The content of the artwork must be appropriate for the contestant's age group and education level, with a clear message.

- The participating artwork (drawing) should not exceed four feet (1380×690mm) in size. The artwork may be presented on A3 paper (297×420mm) and can include oil paintings, pastel drawings, watercolors, sketches, and other creative art forms.

- The participating artwork must be original, and each participant can only submit one artwork.

- The back of the artwork should include full information as per the provided template:

- The participating artwork must be created by an individual child of the correct age group and not by a group of authors.

- The Organizing Committee is not responsible for any artworks lost during transportation.

4. Some Notes When Participating in the Contest:

- The artwork must not violate third-party copyrights or be copied. It must not have been displayed, exhibited, or published in any publications, books, magazines, or any mass media outlets.

- Contestants are fully responsible for ensuring copyright compliance and for any potential disputes regarding the copyright of their participating artwork.

- The Organizing Committee will not return any submitted artworks and has the right to own and use all the artworks from the contest for promotional purposes after the competition.

5. Prizes

The Organizing Committee will award prizes for each group, each group includes: 01 Outstanding Prize. 03 First Prizes, 10 Second Prizes and 15 Third Prizes. All participants will receive Certificate of the Organizing Committee.

Prize-awarded participants will receive a corresponding souvenir from the Organizing Committee.
